Food Vendor Policy

Event Schedule:

- The event will take place from 12pm to 10pm.
- Setup hours are from 7am to 11am.
- Vendors arriving after 11am will not be admitted.

Readiness for Sales:

- Food vendors must be prepared to start sales at 12pm.

License Requirements:

- Food vendors must possess valid licenses or permits for food trucks.
- Temporary Food Vendor License:
- Food trucks from counties other than Marion must obtain a temporary food vendor license.

Payment Deadline:

- Payment must be sent as soon as possible to reserve the space.
- Payments are non-refundable.

Inclement Weather:

- In case of adverse weather conditions such as rain, snow, strong winds, or extreme cold, we reserve the right to postpone the event. The safety and comfort of all participants are our top priority. Any decision to postpone the event will be made with sufficient notice to properly notify all vendors and attendees.

Accuracy of Information:

- All provided information must be accurate.

Cleaning and Trash Disposal:

- Vendors are responsible for cleaning their designated area.
- Trash must be deposited in the containers located at the back of the building.

Prohibition of Alcohol Sales:

- Alcohol sales are prohibited.

Space Dimensions:

Each vendor space has dimensions of 30 feet by 10 feet.
